Eduardo Souto de Moura nasce no Porto (Portugal) a 25 de Julho de 1952.

Licencia-se em Arquitectura pela Escola Superior de Belas-Artes do Porto em 1980.

Colabora com o arquitecto Noé Dinis em 1974.

Colabora com o arquitecto Álvaro Siza Vieira desde 1975 a 1979.

Colabora com o arquitecto Fernandes de Sá de 1979 a 1980.

De 1981 a 1991 trabalha como Professor Assistente do curso de Arquitectura na FAUP.

Inicia a actividade como profissional liberal em 1980.

Professor convidado em Paris-Belleville, Harvard, Dublin, Zurich, Lausanne e Mantova.

Recebeu vários prémios e participou em vários Seminários e Conferências em Portugal e no estrangeiro. Em 2011 recebe o Prémio Pritzker e em 2013 o Prémio Wolf.

Eduardo Souto de Moura was born on the 25th of July, 1952, in Oporto, Portugal.

He studied architecture at the School of Fine Arts in Oporto, receiving his degree in 1980.

In 1974 he collaborated in the architectural practice of Noé Dinis.

From 1975 to 1979 he collaborated in the architectural practice of Álvaro Siza.

From 1981 to 1991, he was assistant professor in his alma mater, and later began to serve as professor in the Faculty of Architecture in the University of Oporto.

He has been visiting professor at the architectural schools of Paris-Belleville, Harvard, Dublin, ETH Zurich, Lausanne and Mantova.

He has participated in numerous seminars and given many lectures both in Portugal and abroad.

His work has appeared in various publications and exhibitions. In 2011 he received the Pritzker Prize and in 2013 the Wolf Prize.
